Activities:

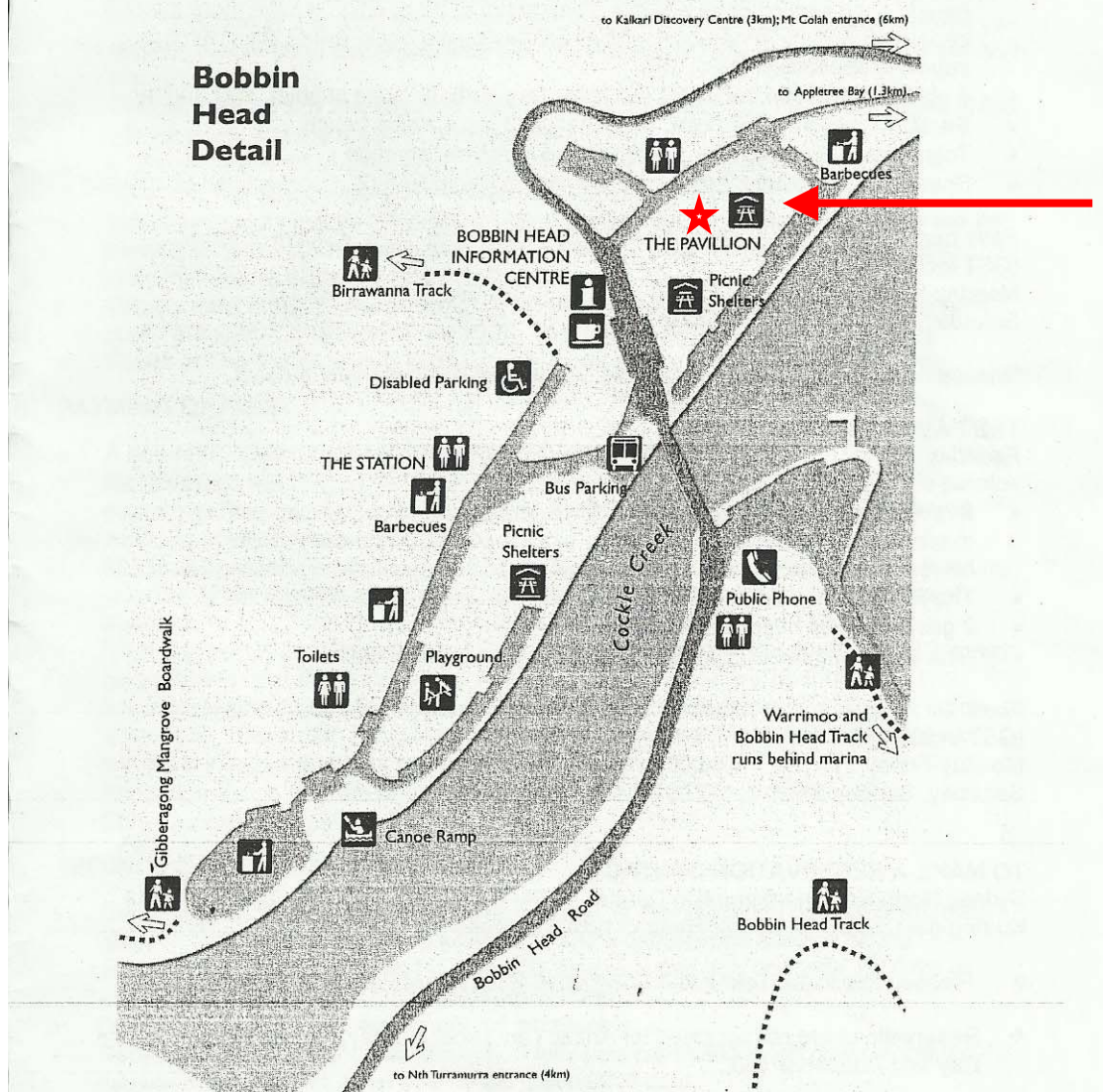
- Something for every one:
